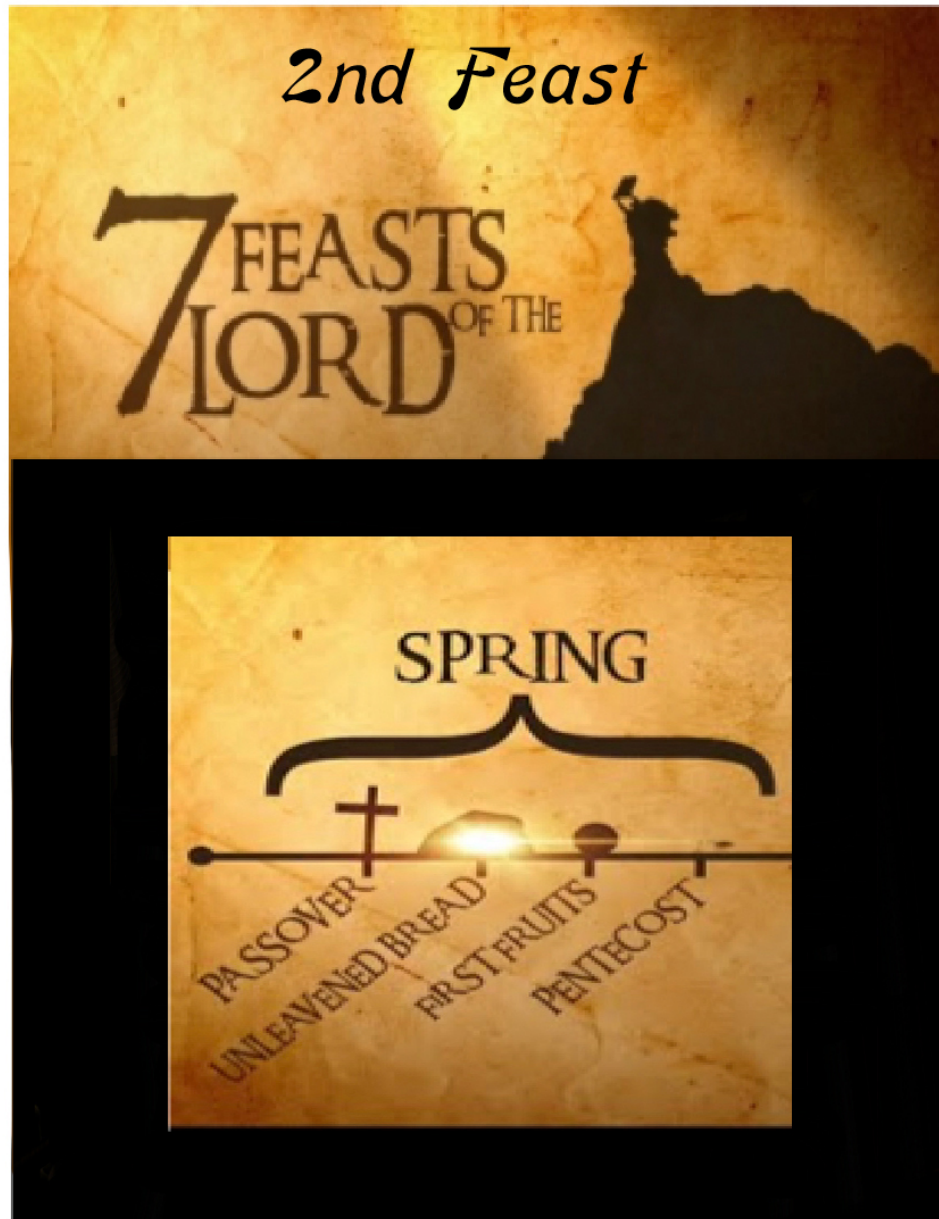
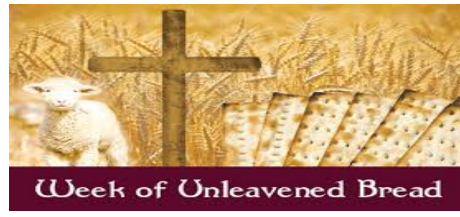

FEAST OF UNLEAVEN BREAD – THE BURIAL

Exodus 12:15-20: *Seven days shall you eat unleavened bread; even the first day you shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whoever eats leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.*

16 *And in the first day there shall be an holy convocation, and in the seventh day there shall be an holy convocation to you; no manner of work shall be done in them, save that which every man must eat, that only may be done of you.*

17 *And you shall observe the feast of unleavened bread; for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall you observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever.*

18 *In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at even, you shall eat unleavened bread, until the one and twentieth day of the month at even.*

19 *Seven days shall there be no leaven found in your houses: for whoever eats that which is leavened, even that soul shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he be a stranger, or born in the land.*

20 *You shall eat nothing leavened; in all your habitations shall you eat unleavened bread.*

Leviticus 23:6-8: *And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread to the LORD: seven days you must eat unleavened bread.*

7 *In the first day you shall have an holy convocation: you shall do no servile work therein.*

8 *But you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD seven days: in the seventh day is an holy convocation: you shall do no servile work therein.*

This feast follows immediately after Passover. Passover is on the 14th of Nissan and Unleaven Bread is on the 15th of Nissan. The next day. Christ died on the 14th at 3pm and 3 hours later is it the 15th, the time the scriptures required that he be put in the tomb, 6pm.

Important: (Their night started at our 6pm and their day started at 6am)

So it is the evening and then the morning.

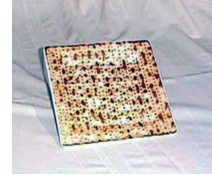
Luke 22:1: *Now the feast of unleavened bread drew near, which is called the Passover.*

Since they were so close together, they just called it the same, Passover. Passover, His death is tied to Unleaven Bread, the burial and to Firstfruits the resurrection of Christ. Thus, Passover.

JESUS IS THE BREAD OF LIFE WITHOUT SIN

Jesus, I am the bread of life.

John 6:35: *Jesus told them, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never become hungry, and whoever believes in me will never become thirsty.*



Matthew 2:1: *Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea when Herod was king. After Jesus' birth wise men from the east arrived in Jerusalem.*

Beth-lehem, where Jesus was born is made up of, of two words. Beth – lehem. Meaning the House of Bread. Jesus was born in the House of Bread. Messiah was the Unleaven Bread. Unleaven, without puffing up, without arrogance, without sin.

Hebrews 4:15: *For we have not a high priest who is not able to be touched by the feelings of our feeble flesh; but we have one who has been tested in all points as we ourselves are tested, but **without sin**.*

Remember on that on the 14th of Nissan in Egypt, they lost their first born if the household did not have the blood painted on the doorpost. On the 15th of Nissan they buried them. God lost his son on the 14th of Nissan and on the next day, the 15th, the Fathers first-born son is buried.

WHY IS THE FEAST OF UNLEAVEN BREAD 7 DAYS LONG?

Nissan 15 – 21

Leviticus 23:5-6 *"The 14 day of the first month, in the evening, is the LORD's Passover. The 15 day of this same month is the LORD's Festival of Unleavened Bread. For seven days you must eat unleavened bread.*



'seven days'

This speaks of the 7 days of creation.

2Peter 3:8: *But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, **that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.***

Each of the 7 days of creation speak of the 7,000 years of man.

The lamb was without sin and spotless for all 7 days, for all 7,000 years of man's of sins were covered by the blood he shed.

Revelation of John 13:8: *And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.*

Genesis 2:3: *And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.*

OLD LEAVEN – SIN

1 Corinthians 5:7-8: Purge out therefore the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, as you are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

8 Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

No leaven for 7 days was to be found in the houses.

This feast followed the Passover, after salvation. We must purge away sin at salvation.

WE ARE GOD'S NEW CREATION WITHOUT SPOT OR BLEMISH

1 Peter 1:15-21: But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;

16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

17 And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear:

18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers;

*19 But with **the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:***

20 Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you,

21 Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.

We were not saved just to save us, but to give us 'new life' with which we should now live in. All of the past is erased, is gone, no longer exists. We are now heavenly women, created with God's DNA. He is now our father, and we are His. Chosen and desired. We have His Life, New Life a new creation without spot or blemish.

2 Corinthians 5:17: Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Ephesians 4:21: If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus:

22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

*24 And that ye put **on the new man**, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.*

2 Timothy 2:19: Nevertheless the foundation of God stand sure, having this seal, The Lord knows them that are his. And, Let every one that names the name of Christ depart from iniquity.

Depart from iniquity Leaven is a type of sin, it's a mold that grows.

Matthew 13:33: *Another parable spake he unto them; The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven, which a woman took, and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened.*

1 Corinthians 5:6: *Your glorying is not good. Don't you know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump?*

FOUR DIFFERENT KINDS OF LEAVEN

1. Old Leaven. The Sin From Our Old Life

1 Corinthians 5:7: *Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:*

Leviticus 18:3: *After the doings of the land of Egypt, wherein ye dwelt, shall ye not do: and after the doings of the land of Canaan, whither I bring you, shall ye not do: neither shall ye walk in their ordinances.*

2. Leaven Of Malice And Wickedness

1 Corinthians 5:8: *Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.*

Ephesians 4:31: *Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamor, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:*

1 Peter 2:1: *Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speaking*

3. Leaven Of The Pharisees

Luke 12:1: *In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.*

4. Leaven Of False Doctrine

Gal 5:1-10

1 Corinthians 5:3: *For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present, concerning him that hath so done this deed,*

8: *Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.*

We are also to purge the sin out of the assembly.

Celebrated in Water Baptism

Romans 6:3-5: Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection

1. His Death – ‘Baptized into his death’
2. His Burial – ‘Buried with him into death’
3. His Resurrection – ‘Like as Christ was raised up from the dead’
