

These were two words released to a class that attended *Developing in the Prophetic Workshop 2* on 26 March 2022. Received as I was preparing the material. These were given to me as I was preparing the course.

Stop Being Afraid

Stop being afraid of me.

If you are afraid of me, you won't seek me with your whole heart.

You won't seek what you fear. You'll turn away from me.

Your service and attention to me out of fear will turn to duty and appeasement. You won't really want to do it.

I want to visit with each of you personally. Face to face.

I know how to make this relationship work. I know who you are and what you're made of.

I knew what you would become.

It's time to really show you who I am...and what I can do.

Come and see! Open the door to me. Invite me in. Let's take walks together and really share.

I want to make our love complete...where you have full and total access. Full and complete trust.

You don't have to be afraid of me. I love you and I have you. You're mine and now I want you to experience our love. Will you let me do that?

Talk to me. Call to me. Ask me things. I'm here and ready to share with you.

My word says that there is no fear in love. My perfect love drives out fear. (1 John 4:18)

Do you have issues? Do you have problems you say? Invite me into that. Watch what I can do.

This word did not come from a direct quote, but from impressions from Holy Spirit.

I'm Not Looking to Harm You

Jesus is **not** looking to set you up to pull the rug out from underneath you. Don't let the relationship between you and Him be diminished because of propaganda of demon spirits.

There is a spirit of fear that says that God is blessing you so that He can set you up for a catastrophe, an illness, a loss of a family member so that He can test you.

Jesus is not looking to visit you, have encounters with you, bless you with His presence, move on you in a mighty way...and then leave you. He doesn't do mood swings.

- This is a walk of faith, not fear.
- If I get too close to Jesus...if I get too zealous, something will be allowed to attack me. I might suffer. My family might suffer.
- This spirit wants you to retreat from Him. Play it safe by being dead (having dead faith).
- You may hear a voice that says, "You're getting too zealous...too emotional...this is unstable..." "You need to settle down. Don't go overboard. You've got to maintain relevance."
- This spirit wants you to be satisfied with a knowledge of God, but with no deep experience with Him. That's too risky.

Have you ever said or hinted this...

"Lord, this is too good to be true. Thank you. I am so blessed. O.K., when's the catastrophe coming?" (This almost gets insulting to Holy Spirit.) Listen to this...

Matt 7:9-11 = Which of you, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? So if you who are evil know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!... (Berean Study Bible)

Luke 11:11-13 = What father among you, if his son asks for a fish, will give him a snake instead? Or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? So if you who are evil know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"...

(Snakes and scorpions are types for demon spirits. Eggs speak of things of value or of life.)

He wants us in love with Him where we are ready to give our all. He promises to be there. You have guardians around you. This is a love that's shared, not one-sided like some appeasement for a false god or idol.

True, demonic spirits get stirred up, angry, and want to scream and hiss at you, but we rejoice that our names are written in heaven. (Luke 10:20) The lord says that it's about the relationship, not about what demons do or don't do. Our relationship with the Lord overshadows anything that we do in ministry or what demons will try to do to us.

Also... watch out for statements or messages that stress the idea of "deeper life/paying the price," but also hint that only special people or a privileged class can only do such things. That's a religious spirit. If

you believe that something only belongs to a privileged group, you won't seek it. You won't ask for it. You'll settle.

Keep this in mind. **Everyone has a course that they're on.** We all have some similarities, but some things on your course may be very different when comparisons are made. My course looks different than yours and so on. Remember the story in John 21 regarding Peter. "Lord, what about this guy?"

When someone tells their story of a hardship, a trial, or a lesson that Holy Spirit walks them through, you can appreciate their story...but that doesn't mean or translate that it will also be for you.

Adversaries...yes. Hardships...sure. Are we being asked for in the courts of heaven by the adversary? Yes. Is God looking to get you smacked because He lavished on you or wants to? No.
